Our Monthly Mission Offering for August is Penn-Mar Human Services. Begun in the 1980's by twelve concerned parents, their purpose is to "Transform life into Living" for adults with cognitive and intellectual disabilities. They work 24 hrs./day, 365 days a year providing group homes (22 in our immediate area), day programs and respite care. They transport adults over 2 million miles/year with a fleet of 100 vehicles and they find customized employment for adults with disabilities. Your gifts will help this much needed ministry to continue to grow and serve our community.

During the month of August we will be collecting school supplies to be distributed to families in need in Central York School District. A collection box will be in the narthex beginning Sun.
