We will set up a table for the cookies and will provide hot cocoa! The Christmas Eve services will remain the same as previous years, at 3 PM, 7 PM, and 10 PM.

OFFERING ON SUN. DEC. 17TH-Throughout Advent, we will be focusing our attention on the hope of the coming of Christ and what this gift means in our life. As we detach ourselves from the more consumer aspects of the Christmas season, we will further engage with giving more to our sisters and brothers in the world who are suffering. NEXT Sunday, December 17th, as a congregation, our church offering will go towards Souls for Soles, an organization that distributes pairs of shoes to individuals in need in order to give them the ability to attend school and work. Any designated money (towards the monthly mission or otherwise) will be applied appropriately, but all general fund offering will go towards this meaningful mission. We ask you to consider giving generously to this cause. Please note that we are only accepting monetary contributions to Soles for Souls, and are not accepting donations of shoes. Thank you!

Security Task Force Forming- Church Council is asking for volunteers to serve on a newly forming Security Task Force. The mission of this team will be to assess the security of the building and make recommendations regarding any additional safety measures that need to be in place, particularly in light of recent events in our country. We are seeking volunteers through December 17th, and will convene the group in the new year. *In the meantime*, at the recommendation of Church Council, the church doors will now be locked ten minutes after the 8 AM service begins. Doors will re-open during the Sunday school hour through the first ten minutes of the 10:30 AM service.
