Human Trafficking is modern-day slavery and involves the use of force, fraud, or coercion to obtain labor or a commercial sexual act. Sparrow Place is a non-profit with the vision to open the first restorative residence for survivors of sex trafficking in York. Mt. Zion is teaming up with Sparrow Place and their Dress for Freedom event. We are collecting gently used (like new) dresses and purses. Items can be dropped off on the front porch of Mt. Zion.
