RESPONSE TEAM ANNOUNCEMENT

As a reminder, the COVID Response Team and Church Council announced the wonderful news that as of Sunday, May 23rd, we will be regathering for in person worship at Mt. Zion!

Here are a few details to share with you. We will not be requiring registration ahead of time, and while in the building, we want you to know about the precautions that will be in place.

- Wearing a mask is required. We understand for young children this may not be possible and we certainly offer an exception to the mask policy for our youngest Mt. Zion folks. Children are most certainly welcome in worship!
- Please utilize the hand sanitizer provided.
- Please know we will have both the sanctuary and the fellowship hall available for seating during worship. We have pews marked off to provide distancing between the pews. Within the pews, we ask you to be mindful of the distance between you and your fellow attendees.
- If you would like to socialize after the service, we invite you to visit in the front courtyard or the parking lot.
- For the time being, we will have a children's message, but we will not be offering nursery care or WOW Kids.
- We will be led in worship by a quartet, but at this time we ask that you do not sing along, though you are certainly welcome to hum or sway.
- If you are feeling unwell, we ask that you consider watching from home.
- We look forward to seeing all of you!


