

Scripture: Revelation 7:9-17

Main Idea: In the book of Revelation, a man named John was given a vision of what heaven is like. Here he sees that there are lots of people together who no longer feel hungry, thirsty, or in pain. But instead they are gathered together to celebrate and give thanks to God for all they are given. In other parts of the Bible we hear other things about heaven like that there will be a great feast and that God has a house with many, many, *many* rooms in it for all of us. Thinking about Heaven can sometimes be hard because we don't know exactly what it looks like—but what we do know is that it will be a place where we will be happy, our needs will be met, and we'll be re-united with those that we love so so much but have died. No matter what that looks like—it's worth celebrating!
